#### 2023 American Urological Association



We are pleased to announce that this year, Drs. Brian Dinerman, Guillaume Farah, Kyle Waisanen had the privilege of presenting abstracts at the annual American Urological Association meeting. This event was held during the last weekend of April.

Dr. Waisanen presented, "Percutaneous Urethral Sphincter Stimulation: Swine model for feasibility of use with intrinsic sphincter deficiency stress urinary incontinence" focusing on assessing the viability of percutaneous external urethral sphincter access and urethral pressure profiles associated with direct electric sphincteric stimulation. Dr. Farah presented, "Closing the Gender Gap in Urology and Other Surgical Specialties" bringing light to trends in the gender of matched urology applicants. This sheds light on prevailing trends pertaining to the gender distribution of matched urology applicants, aiming to address and rectify any gender disparities within the field.

#### **Recent Resident Publications**

Dr. Waisanen had a paper published in the electronic journal, Cureus. This paper, titled "Renal-Protective Urinoma Formation in a Newborn Boy With Posterior Urethral Valves" was published in June 2023. The article demonstrates a unique case of antenatal detection of

Posterior urethral valves (PUV) in a male infant with postnatal complicated urinoma formation secondary to forniceal rupture. Despite some complications, the patient recovered rapidly after intervention and was discharged in stable condition.
